7certain you will be able to use the mentorship of their lives to fortify your own without
8additional coaching.

10Below is a more complete listing of Jedi Masters with references (without page numbers).
11The numbers after some of the names helps distinguish which one they are referring to, as
12several names are in the Holocron more than once and refer to different people in
13different time periods. For instance, Alma(1) is the father of Alma(2), and the names
14Moroni(1) and Moroni(2) are present with over 400 hundred years between them. The
